Given its significant size as one of the largest entrances to your home, consistent upkeep is vital to preserve both the aesthetic appeal and functionality of your garage door. Implementing a biannual maintenance schedule can effectively mitigate accidents and potential damage to your garage doors. To uphold your warranty and ensure the optimal performance of your garage door system, refrain from attempting any repair procedures on your own. Instead, rely on your trusted DIGBY BUILT dealer who possesses the necessary expertise and knowledge to address any substantial damage effectively.

Recommended

We recommend using glass cleaner product for the windows
Microfiber cloth for any cleaning on the door.
Contact the installing company for a general service at least every two years.

Not Recommended

Do not use any solvents
Do not use any all-purpose cleaners
Do not use any degreasers
Do not use and adhesive removers
Do not use bleach or mix chemicals
Do not use any acetone based products
Do not pressure wash the door

Lubrication

Lubrication on hinges, rollers, bearings, and springs are highly recommended to be done annually. (Please contact the installing company for this service)
When spraying hinges wipe any excess so it does not fall onto the aluminum or glass, it can cause damage.
Tracks do not need lubrication.
